AMPUTEE FOOTBALL

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- ✤ Is one of the fastest-growing disciplines worldwide
- It currently exists in over 70 countries, including 19 in Europe
- WAFF is the governing body for amputee football in the world
- Section 2017 EAFF is the governing body for amputee football in Europe
- Regular competitions on a grand scale, including World Cups, European
 Championships, and other continental championships are being organized.
- Furthermore, Club Champions Leagues are consistently held, highlighting the sport's global and regional prominence.

Discipline is gaining popularity within the larger football community. The EAFF EURO final held in Turkey attracted a live audience of 41,000 enthusiastic fans at the stadium, while the EAFF EURO event in Poland drew thousands of spectators to the stadiums and hundreds of thousands in front of their television screens.
 Amputee football is supported by UEFA, many national Fas & famous players like Robert Lewandowski.

AMPUTEE FOOTBALL

- Amputee Football is football for people after one-sided amputation or inborn limb defects
- Solution Field players play with one leg and move on crutches
- Goalkeepers with both legs play with one arm
- International matches are played 7-a-side on 60x40 meter pitches, with 5x2,2 m goals and time of play 2x25 minutes with 10 minutes brake

Junior Camp is a flagship EAFF event. Since 5 years we are inviting children with one-side amputations or limb defects (5-16 years old with) from Europe and other continents and we are creating for them equal opportunity to play football, speak universal language of sport and develop new skills.

It is also the chance for coaches to exchange knowledge and inspire others to create more programs after the camp is over and for the parents to have stronger bond with their kids.



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EAFF JUNIOR CAMP

The camp lasts 5 days, of which 3 days on the pitch: trainings, matches. The kids are divided into age groups. There are two trainings a day. Besides trainings we conduct workshops for parents and coaches. Additionally, there are integration activities between coaches, parents and participants and activities allowing participant to get to know the culture of hosting country.
